#### Parish Roof Project—Update:

Thanks to all parish families who have been donating to our Building Fund in support of our roof project! As of June 28th the fund stands at \$472,700. Of this amount, about \$147,700 has been raised since the start of our roof project fundraising campaign in early May; the rest was already in the Building Fund, generously donated over the previous few years. The stained glass windows have been removed as part of the roof work. The other major work on the roof will begin later in July. In the meantime, the contractor is making new window frames and will install glass into those frames. Hardware is being made to hold the stained glass in place. The windows are a key part of installing the building membrane that will prevent moisture from accumulating in the church walls and roof. That is why the roof work is starting with the windows. Then the work will continue upwards from there, and include the upper walls and the main roof. That will be followed by work on the highest parts of our roof, that is, the lantern windows, walls and roof. The entire project should be completed by the end of September. During the summer, we will be providing further roof project updates in the Parish bulletin, on the Parish website, and through the fundraising thermometer in the welcoming area. If you are making monthly contributions to the Roof Project/Building Fund, we hope you will continue to do so during the summer. An easy way to donate is online through our parish website. If you buy groceries, then please consider buying grocery gift cards from the Knights of Columbus the first weekend in July and August.
