Parish Roof Project—Update:

A big thanks to all parishioners and parish groups that have contributed to the Building Fund to date! Due to your generosity, the Fund now stands at \$451,000, or close to 60% of the funds required to cover the full cost of our extensive roof project. About \$125,000 of this total was raised since the start of our fundraising campaign in early May. The rest was generously donated over the past few years. **Special thanks to the parishioners who sold African food last weekend to raise \$700 for the roof project!** The food was delicious! As you may be planning your summer vacation, please keep the roof project in mind.

The work to repair the roof will continue through the summer months, to the end of September. If you are making monthly contributions, we hope you continue do so during the summer.
