Every year on the first Sunday of November, we observe Catholic Education Sunday. We take time to give thanks to God for the blessing of Catholic education, and we pray in a special way for all students, teachers, staff, administrators and trustees of our Catholic schools.

In their annual message for Catholic Education Sunday, which this year falls on November 4, the bishops of Alberta and the Northwest Territories draw inspiration from Pope Francis' apostolic exhortation *Gaudete et Exsultate*, On the Call to Holiness in Today's World. They speak of the importance of encouraging students to grow in their faith, to live its principles, and to act in ways that make a positive difference in their local community and the world. And they express gratitude for parents who entrust their children to our Catholic School system and for parishes that minister to them.
